The slides were pictures of bridges and the various routes around our part of the world and further afield. One such route was the 'Jaggermen's Route. The Jaggermen plied their trade transporting goods along the packhorse trails. Marsden to Rochdale with Lame Luke O'Marsden. Lots of routes in this area built by Blind Jack O'Knaresborough. Marsden central

to the trades routes with two packhorse bridges. Mellor bridge in the centre of the town and the bridge with three names. The official name for the bridge at Hey Green, just out of the centre of Marsden, is 'Close Gate'. The 'Packhorse Inn' was nearby and was run by a lady called Esther Schofield. The bridge became known as Esther's Gate Bridge which was corrupted to 'Eastergate Bridge'. The third name used by the locals was 'Th'owd Bridge'. Salters Route was from the salt mines of Cheshire over the Pennines and on to Sheffield. Graham played a video of a bicycle following the pack horse trail across the moors— not Graham on the bicycle and certainly not me. Graham concluded with photographs of his and Marina's favourite bridges. The next time that you are on a narrow winding road—think about pack horses.
